If you are planning a special event you can also place a special order indicating the type of meat and marinade you prefer. A special order must be placed a minimum of six hours prior to pick up to maximize the flavour of marinade.



Our mission is to grow nutritious produce for distribution in emergency food baskets at the Food Bank. Thanks to our dedicated volunteers, last season we harvested 17, 825 lbs of fresh produce.

To have another successful year, we need volunteers! Volunteering is free and you do not need any gardening experience. The Garden Patch provides tools, water and sunscreen. There are three main ways to become involved as a volunteer at the Garden Patch.

Drop in when you are free! Each week we have scheduled volunteer drop-in hours. 
