The City of Saskatoon is planning to construct a water spray feature in Hampton Village in Al Anderson Neighbourhood Park, anticipated during the 2012 construction season.

The concept plan for the water spray feature will be presented at this public information meeting. On the following page is a picture of one of Saskatoon's spray features to give you an idea of what type of amenities may appear in Hampton Village. Residents will have an opportunity to view and provide comments on the Hampton Village concept plan.

The concept plan presentation will be approximately 15 minutes followed by a 30-minute question and answer period.

The City of Saskatoon, Community Development Branch and Infrastructure Services Department will provide information on the Water Spray Feature.

Garage Sale Tips- Set Up & Sale Day

- Be Prepared before Start Time. Early Birds will come, if you advertise an 8:00 am start, people will arrive early (7:30).
- Have enough tables to display your items, if you don't have sturdy tables, set out a clean blanket on the ground to lay your items on. Don't bunch things in boxes. The more items on display the easier it is for buyers.
- Take the time to organize: Keep all glass items together, collectibles together, books and magazines together, toys together, etc. You can use shallow boxes, baskets or tubs to hold glassware (helps prevent them from falling off the table & breaking).
