### Garage Sale Tips- Set Up & Sale Day

• Be Prepared before Start Time. Early Birds will come, if you advertise an 8:00 am start, people will arrive early (7:30).

•Have enough tables to display your items, if you don't have sturdy tables, set out a clean blanket on the ground to lay your items on. Don't bunch things in boxes. The more items on display the easier it if for buyers.

•Take the time to organize: Keep all glass items together, collectibles together, books and magazines together, toys together, etc. You can use shallow boxes, baskets or tubs to hold glassware (helps prevent them from falling off the table & breaking).

•Clothing is best sold if hung neatly on a rack (a broom stick between two ladders works) and price clearly.

### TO BE A GREEN CITY, WE NEED A LITTLE BLUE

Blue recycling carts will be delivered to homes that currently have black garbage carts, beginning in January through to June 2013. Loraas Recycle delivers your new blue recycling cart to the street in front of your house, even if you have back lane collection. Collection begins within two weeks of receiving your cart **REMINDER: Your blue recycling cart must be placed in the** <u>same location as your black garbage cart</u> by 7:00 a.m. on your recycling collection day to ensure service.

Loraas Recycle provides the recycling service and is available during business hours to answer your questions about cart delivery, collections, how to properly use your recycling cart or any other service-related questions you may have.
