HVCA RINK IS OPEN FOR WINTER FUN!

The cold weather has been great for getting an early start to skating and hockey this season. We know several community members who are very happy to see the rink ice. A flooded rink can only happen with dedicated volunteers. If you can volunteer to help maintain the ice email:

Another way you can help is to notify HVCA if you see the red trouble light on the rink shed illuminated. Post a message **as soon as possible** on our

Facebook page to notify all board members so we can respond to the emergency notification.

If the red light is illuminated, the temperature inside the rink shed has dropped. At low temperatures the water line could freeze, eliminating our access to water for rink flooding. The rink and rink shed in Al Anderson Park belong to HVCA—you and me. We all need to look after it!

The rink is for everyone. Thursdays from 6 - 8 and Saturdays and Sundays from 2 - 4 are set aside for public skating times. During these hours, no hockey sticks or pucks are allowed on the ice. HVCA board members will be in attendance during public skate times to ensure everyone has an opportunity to have fun on the ice! Public skating times begin in mid December and run to mid March, weather permitting. If the temperature is -25 or lower (with wind chill), there will be no public skating. It is also important to note, if the temperature is too warm, we ask people not to skate as this too will damage the ice. Thanks! See you at the rink!

Rev. Keitha Ogbogu recently announced that she has accepted the lead pastor position at West Springs Free Methodist Church in Calgary, effective February 1, 2019. Pastor Keitha has led the Hampton Free Methodist congregation for the past 10 years, including the move to Hampton Village. Keitha has taken the approach that a church is not just in a community but must be part of the community. Even prior to the opening of the church in Hampton Village she developed a relationship with the Hampton Village Community Association (HVCA), attending their meetings and presenting plans for the new building well before construction started. HVCA events are regularly announced in the church bulletin and she encourages members to participate as

much as possible. She also encouraged the church to open its facilities to the neighbourhood, with the result that HVCA, the city, condo associations, Boys and Girls Club, and many families use the space on a regular basis. Church programming was developed to reflect the needs of the community with a pre-school and play group for young children, craft days for home businesses, an international emphasis to welcome newcomers to Canada, as well as study groups for those interested in the Christian faith. Her leadership has made Hampton Free Methodist Church a part of the community. We will miss her, her husband C.Y., and their sons Samuel and Emmanuel. 

HVCA Advertising rates to increase

At the 2018 HVCA AGM, membership approved an increase to the cost of advertising in the HVCA newsletter.

The increase is effective for the **Spring 2019** edition of the newsletter.

A full-page advertisement will increase from \$100.00 to \$200.00. A half-page advertisement will increase from \$75.00 to \$100.00. unchanged at \$25.00.


Prices are per newsletter edition. All ads are published in the newsletter which is also posted to our webpage. Ads must be submitted camera ready pdf or jpeg formats
