

<u>Build New</u> - Currently there is NO FUNDING plan that has


been approved by City Council on this project. The "Build New" model would only be possible with a third party private partner and funding from both levels of Government. I **WILL NOT SUPPORT** moving forward if tax payers are expected to cover the cost. The land has been purchased by the Saskatoon land bank for the future site, if this doesn't move forward the Saskatoon land bank has the option to sell the land back into the market. Planning, and building a new arena takes roughly 6-8 years.



Renovate - This would need to occur in the next 8-10 years. This would involve closure of SaskTel Centre for a period of time. A private partner for renovations is unlikely as is funding from other levels of Government. The estimated cost for the renovation of SaskTel Centre is roughly 300 million dollars.








HAMPTON VILLAGE BUSINESS PARK CONCEPT PLAN UPDATE

Progress continues to move forward on the business park in Hampton Village with our two key owners of the land, DREAM and Kahkewistahaw First Nation. At the February City Council meeting, Council approved the proposed amendments to the land in the Hampton Business Park. There will be announcements coming on additional businesses coming to the Hampton Village Business park. I have met with the land owners on several occasions asking for additional amenities that include a grocery store, gym, restaurants, car wash etc...
