WARD 4 UPDATE HAMPTON VILLAGE

DOWNTOWN EVENT & ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT - 10 YEAR VISION - UPDATE

Build New - Currently there is NO FUNDING plan that has been approved by City Council on this project. The “Build New” model would only be possible with a third party private partner and funding from both levels of Government. I **WILL NOT SUPPORT** moving forward if tax payers are expected to cover the cost. The land has been purchased by the Saskatoon land bank for the future site, if this doesn’t move forward the Saskatoon land bank has the option to sell the land back into the market. Planning, and building a new arena takes roughly 6-8 years.

UPDATE - City Administration has been in negotiations with the private third party partner, they hope to bring that information to council at the end of July, or to the Council committee meeting in August to share how much money the private partner is willing to invest into the district.

SASKATOON TRANSIT - EMPLOYEE AND CUSTOMER SAFETY

Bus operators, supervisors and customer service employees have been exposed to more aggressive and violent incidents this spring. Every employee deserves to feel safe at work and Saskatoon Transit is actively taking measures to provide a safe environment for front-line employees and customers.

Saskatoon Transit works with the Saskatoon Police Service, Saskatoon Fire Department, Amalgamated Transit Union Local 615 and other community stakeholders to address transit bus and facility safety concerns, as a larger "One City" community safety strategy and is committed to the Saskatoon Transit front-line employee and customer safety plan.

Fire Community Support Team Have Arrived For Transit - The FCS workers completed their training this week and have started their full-time rotation. The role of the FCS workers is similar to the more familiar CSP but with the addition of six full-time staff members and increased support for Saskatoon Transit. The FCS team will routinely patrol and engage with individuals in the business areas, on Saskatoon Transit buses, and at bus terminals. They will also ride and patrol targeted bus routes where incidents are more frequent. These routes will be selected based on data collected by the City.
