

CITY COUNCIL UPDATE HAMPTON VILLAGE

IN DECEMBER, DREAM ANNOUNCED IT HAD SIGNED AN AGREEMENT WITH MCDONALD'S TO OPEN A LOCATION IN HAMPTON VILLAGE. THIS PARTNERSHIP SERVES AS A MAJOR ANCHOR TENANT, POISED TO ATTRACT MORE BUSINESSES TO THE AREA.

ADDITIONALLY, KAHKEWISTAHAW FIRST NATION IS CURRENTLY CONSTRUCTING "PHASE 2" OF THEIR DEVELOPMENT, WHICH WILL FEATURE SEVERAL BUSINESSES IN A MODERN STRIP MALL-STYLE BUILDING. LOOKING AHEAD, "PHASE 3" OF THE PROJECT PROMISES TO BRING EVEN MORE EXCITEMENT TO THE AREA WITH THE INCLUSION OF TWO HOCKEY ARENAS, A HOTEL, AND A CONFERENCE AND ENTERTAINMENT CENTER, FURTHER ENHANCING THE REGION'S APPEAL AND INFRASTRUCTURE.

COYOTES UPDATE

IN 2024, THE CITY RECEIVED 214 CALLS REGARDING COYOTES IN THE CITY COMPARED TO 16 SIGHTINGS IN 2022. COUNCIL HAS IDENTIFIED THIS AS A PROBLEM AND HAS ASKED ADMINISTRATION TO CREATE A BYLAW, AND POSSIBLE FINES FOR RESIDENTS WHO ARE FEEDING COYOTES. COUNCIL APPROVED THE RECCOMENDATION FOR THE CITY TO MOVE FORWARD, AND ALIGN WITH WHAT OTHER MAJOR CITIES IN WESTERN CANADA ARE DOING WITH COTYOTES. THIS INCLUDES AVERSION CONDITIONING AND TARGETED EUTHANASIA. CITY ADMINISTRATION HAS COMMITTED TO ENSURE TIMELY RESPONSES TO SERIOUS COMPLAINTS ABOUT COYOTES. AN INCREASE IN BUDGET MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE FUTURE.
